New England Telephone has filed with the D.P.U. for authority to bill Interexchange carriers on an individual case basis when a request for special service is received. Presently, the only company this involves is AT&T Communications, which uses NET as its billing agent. These charges would apply in cases where NET must provide a service in order to adjust a customer's ATTCOM bill. In addition to these charges, NET has also filed to provide three new billing options to Interexchange carriers.

The Department will conduct a pre-hearing conference on this matter on Tuesday, February 12, 1985, at 10:00 a.m. at its Hearing Room, No. 1210, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Mass.
