Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to cause certain necessary repairs to be made on the stone crusher at the city yard: also to erect a new elevator and bins, and put in a suitable foundation for the same. The expense thereof not to exceed the sum of Twenty four Hundred Dollars, (\$2400.-) the same to be charged to the appropriation for that Department, (maintenance.)

The repairs before mentioned to be made without advertising for proposals for the same.
