WHEREAS: Jesse was a member of Company C, 1st Battalion, 151st Field Artillery, 34th Infantry Division, Minnesota Army National Guard; and

WHEREAS: Jesse's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family; and

WHEREAS: Jesse will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Sergeant Jesse Lhotka at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
