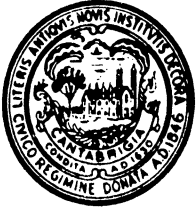

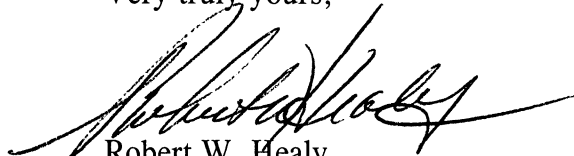

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached please find an appropriation order for \$90,000 for the Employee Benefits, Retirement Fund. The funds from this appropriation will be used to grant a \$300 annual increase in the annual pension of those retirees whose pensions currently equals less than 50% of the annual compensation of the position from which they retired from. This appropriation request is in response to Committee Report Order #5A. The adjustment in pensions will be retroactive to July 1, 1999, and will be funded from Free Cash.
