AFTER SCHOOL CHILDCARE 1982-1983

The Department of Human Service Programs, through Neighborhood Councils, currently sponsors nine after-school childcare programs for children in grades Kindergarten through second or third (and up).

Programs are located either within the elementary school or in a nearby community facility. Group size ranges from 12 - 40. Enrollment is generally open to children living within the immediate community or who attend the elementary school the program serves.

Parents are urged to participate on Parent Committees and are involved in the selection of staff and determining curriculum.
