REDDICK, SR. attended what was then known as Rindge Technical High School, where he excelled in sports, most notably track and field, for which he was voted Team MVP in 1973, and football, for which he was voted Football Rookie of the Year in 1971, and was named to the Boston All Scholastic team in 1973 and 1974; and

WHEREAS: Upon graduation from high school, ROGER W. REDDICK, SR. won a four year football scholarship to Boston College, where he received the "Unsung Hero" Award, as well as the William Supple Memorial Trophy; and

WHEREAS: ROGER W. REDDICK, SR., of late an employee of the Raytheon Company, continued his commitment to athletic excellence by volunteering as a coach in the Pop Warner C-League, and always served a teacher and role model for youth in his community; and

WHEREAS: ROGER W. REDDICK, SR. is survived by his loving wife of sixteen years, Francine L. (Greene), and seven wonderful children - Roger Jr., Francis Earl, Mijid. A., Devon Reddick, Nerecesa Nadine, Jenny Francine Debrielle, and Latoya Reddick; and

WHEREAS: ROGER W. REDDICK, SR. was also the devoted son of Cornelius T. Reddick, Jr. and Nadine B. (Wright) Reddick, and the beloved brother of Clark, Brian, Gary, and Chico Reddick, and Gloria J. Jones; and

WHEREAS: ROGER W. REDDICK, Sr. also leaves behind a godson, Desmond L. Daley, as well as a host of loving relatives and friends; and

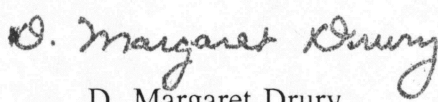
RESOLVED: That the City Clerk hereby is requested to present a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family of ROGER W. REDDICK, SR.
