The **Committee** on Government and Legislative Operations conducted a public meeting to review the status of the Recodification of the General Ordinances.

Councillor Francis Duehay, Chairman of the Committee, stated that he believed the draft of the General Ordinances should be accepted as Phase I of the overall recodification process since it represents a compilation and restructuring of all the General Ordinances since 1972. He stated that the City Clerk in conjunction with the City Solicitor and City Manager were implementing the formal recodification vote taken by the City Council on January 26, 1987.

Councillor Duehay further requested that these three individuals continue to work on Phase II of the recodification which would be the correction and deletion of substantive language to be identified by the City i.e. obsolete wording, gaps in any numerical listings and the inclusion of all acts of the Legislature relative to Cambridge.

The meeting was adjourned at ten o'clock and thirty-two minutes a.m.
