It has come to the attention of this City Council that many persons who live in apartments throughout the City do not use the spaces allocated to the apartment and required by the Zoning Ordinance, due to the fact that a separate parking fee is charged in addition to the regular fee prescribed by the lease or tenancy agreement, and

WHEREAS:-

Several parking spaces are not used as a result of this arrangement and the tenants concerned are parking their cars in the city streets adding to the parking problems of the City of Cambridge, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to conduct a thorough study into this matter and report back to this City Council his recommendations for legislation to correct this situation.
