WHEREAS: These are days of great economic and political problems in Ireland and a time when there are estimated to be 150,000 Irish refugees illegally in the United States and living in fear of deportation because of our stringent and inflexible immigration laws; and

WHEREAS: Congressman Joseph Kennedy has introduced on the floor of Congress, legislation to provide for adjustment of status of certain Irish nationals who arrived in the United States before September 1, 1987 and who have continuously resided in the United States since before the end of the period; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record as supporting HR3432, Congressman Joseph Kennedy's Irish Immigration Bill, and urging its passage; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitable engrossed copy of this order to Congressman Joseph Kennedy's Washington Office.
