I am hereby requesting a transfer of \$1,011.00 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary and Wages Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development has approved an amendment to the Homeless Intercept Program.
