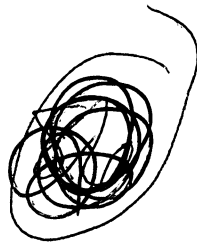

Dukakis named to Amtrak panel

President Clinton yesterday named former Governor Michael S. Dukakis, a longtime advocate of high speed rail, to the new Amtrak Reform Board. The nomination will be sent to the Senate for confirmation shortly. The newly constituted seven-person board also will include Transportation Secretary Rodney Slater, former Virginia Governor Linwood Holton, and Wisconsin Governor Tommy Thompson. Senator John F. Kerry, who was lieutenant governor during Dukakis's second term, recommended Dukakis's appointment months ago, and yesterday he applauded the news, saying the state would have a strong advocate for a world-class rail system with Dukakis.
