Subject: City Council Order #28, dated 1/13/92, Re: Resident
Parking Signs at Somerville City Line

The Traffic and Parking Department working with the City of Somerville has surveyed all the resident parking signs at the City Lines and shall have signs installed by either City indicating where resident parking starts and the direction it follows.

This shall be accomplished by the use of different type of signs for each city with an arrow indicating that the resident parking area starts at that point and proceeds in the direction of the arrow. These signs shall be marked with the letters "CTPD" (Cambridge Traffic & Parking Department) or with a miniature city seal. The City of Somerville has stated that they will use a different type of sign and marking so as to easily distinguish Somerville and Cambridge signs.

The City of Cambridge signs should be completed by April 1, 1992.

RESOLVED: That the City Manager contact the City of Somerville to determine whether a similar program could be accomplished in that city; and be it further

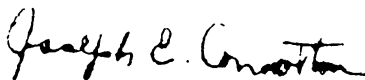
RESOLVED: That the City Manager be requested to report his findings on this matter to the City Council within one month.
