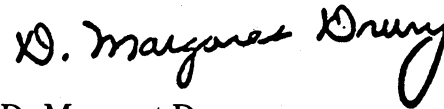

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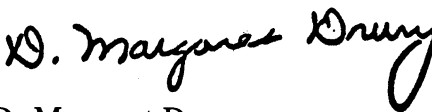

Please be advised that the dedication will take place on **Saturday, June 20th at 10:00 in the morning** at the above referenced streets. I will need a PA System and Podium for the event.

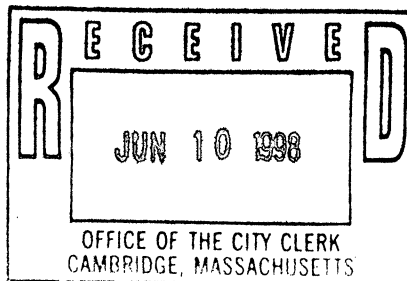
After consulting with the family, they would like a **wood sign** and it should read as follows:

HENRY W. "HANK" VERA SQUARE

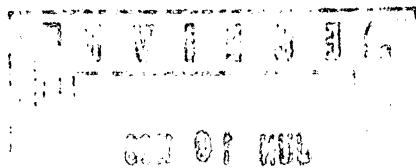
