

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Nov. 9. 1887.

Ordered,

That the lot of land with the materials thereon, known as the "City Gravel Pit", on the border of Fresh Pond, be, and hereby is, turned over to the Cambridge Water Board to be controlled and used by it, as in its judgment the interests of the city will be best subserved; and the Street Department shall be compensated therefor in gravel from Whites Hill, so-called, or any other location, where the water Board may have surplus gravel to dispose of, - as may be agreed upon by the Committee on Roads and Bridges and the water-Board.
