- WHEREAS: Roberta Kalinoski retired on December 31, 1985 after twenty-five years as Executive Director of the Cambridge Camping Association and will be feted by her friends and colleagues at a reception in her honor on February 9, 1986; and
- WHEREAS: Roberta Kalinoski came to North Cambridge as a small child from England and Canada, attending the Ellis, Fitzgerald and Cambridge High and Latin Schools; and
- WHEREAS: Roberta and Anthony Kalinoski are blessed with one child, Elizabeth Lee, who served as Assistant Director of the Cambridge Camping Association, and one grandchild, Victoria; and
- WHEREAS: Roberta Kalinoski, developed the Cambridge Camping Association from a part-time agency operating out of the Cambridge YMCA in 1960 to the greatly expanded and far more comprehensive organization that it is today; and
- WHEREAS: Roberta has developed the Inner City Day Camp at Harvard University which has operated at capacity (180 children) for four two-week periods ever since it opened; the Inner City Day Camp Program on Saturdays for children whose parents work on week-ends; the resident camp program; and the Respite Care Vacation Camp; and
- WHEREAS: In all her work Roberta has worked to ensure that children with special needs are especially included and that her agency interacted with many other Cambridge agencies to ensure that all needy Cambridge children were touched by her programs;
- WHEREAS: In her honor the Roberta Kalinoski Campership Fund for needy children has been established; and
- WHEREAS: Roberta Kalinoski's accomplishments have been marked by her energy, enthusiasm and love for those her programs reached; now, therefore be it
- RESOLVED That this City Council congratulate Roberta Kalinoski for her 25 years of leadership to the Cambridge Camping Association and thank her for the many significant contributions she has made to the lives of thousands of Cambridge children; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council wish Roberta and Anthony Kalinoski and their family many more years of happiness, good health, and success.
