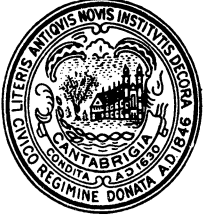

SUBJECT: Communication #032 dated 9/9/96

RE: Petition from Alice Locicero, et al, requesting a walk light or other traffic control options for the intersection of Grove Street and Blanchard Road.

During the 1992-1993 the Town of Belmont developed several conceptual improvements to the intersection of Blanchard Road, Grove Street, Bright Road and Washington Street which, except for Blanchard road is in the town of Belmont. After several public meetings, the abutters, including several Cambridge residents, agreed upon option B-4. this option included the following:

1. Stopping Blanchard Road traffic
2. Reduce the width of Blanchard Road
3. Added a small traffic divisional island on Blanchard Road at Grove Street

On April 12, 1993, we sent a letter to Belmont stating we had no objection to their proposal.

According to Mr. Gatzunis, Belmont Town Engineer, later on the residents opposed any changes to this intersection and the project was dropped by the Town Selectman
