MAYOR VELLUCCI

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested and urged to assemble a team of Cambridge Police Detectives to investigate the appearance of Professional Ambulances on each and every church procession held on each and every Sunday, between the hour of 4:00 and 5:00 p.m., in front of the Harrington School on Cambridge Street, and which causes disruption. It is said by the Reverend Jose Ferreira, Pastor of the Saint Anthony Church in East Cambridge, that "the ambulances seem to appear everytime we have a procession. They come "tearing down" Cambridge Street, always at the same hour, always at the same place, always on Sunday during the procession. They come at full speed with horns and sirens going at full blast." Father Ferreira further says, "I believe someone is calling the Professional Ambulances only to disrupt the procession. It puts the safety of many little children in the procession in jeopardy."; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to investigate the logs and tapes of the Professional Ambulance Service, and to talk with Father Ferreira, and to report back to the City Council with a full explanation of this investigation.
