ORDERED:

That if it is determined that \$15,000.00 can be allocated that said sum be immediately transferred to the Department of Traffic and Parking in order to purchase the necessary equipment to install said traffic light.

Residents of Cocoran Park neighborhood and the headmasters of Buckingham, Browne & Nichols, Buckingham Lower school, Friends School, Peabody School and St. Peters School demand the installation of a Traffic Light and Pedestrian Light at the intersection of Upland Road and Raymond Street.

In the course of this year there have been seven accidents at the above intersection all involving bodily injury or damage to property in excess of \$200.00. In addition there have been many more minor accidents.

In the last twenty years there have been five fatalities, one of them a child on his way to school. In the present condition it is only a matter of time before there is another tragedy.

The undersigned strongly urge that authorities take immediate action to install a traffic light and pedestrian light to terminate this continuing accident hazard.
