Subject Communication from Gary M. Elovitz, of 55A Market St. to make Market St.
two way

I have reviewed the request by Gary M. Elovitz Secretary of 55A Market Street Condominium Trust to make Market Street two way. The street was made one way after many meetings with the residents of the area and discussions with the police, fire and public works departments.

The purpose of making it one way was to remove through traffic on this street to make it safer for all at an inconvenience to the drivers. At the time the survey was taken, the results showed a 3 to 1 ratio in favor of the one way pattern.

I have discussed the situation with the headmaster of the Fletcher School, Fire Department and the Cambridge Police and they all agree that Market Street should remain one way for the safety of school children. The one way has also improved the accident hazards in this area as children walking to school have to look in one direction only.

Therefore, it is my recommendation that Market Street remain one way from Elm Street to Columbia Street.

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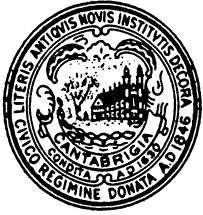
