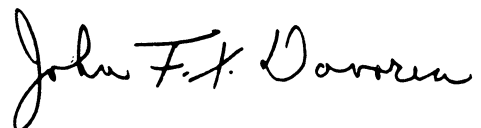

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The purpose of the Franciscan Fraternity of Peace and Love, Inc. is to advance, foster and promote Franciscan ideals and lifestyle in our society. Recognizing our responsibility to provide for the needs of our less fortunate brothers and sisters, we come together to apply the fruits of our prayer life and combined charitable activities to alleviate the suffering and rejection of the poor - especially the derelict and outcast of our society. We were founded in 1970 by Brother James Curran, O.S.F., a member of the Third Order of Saint Francis, who was inspired with a few friends to investigate the possibility of living, in the twentieth century, a community life as envisioned by Saint Francis in the twelfth century: based on the message of the Gospel and giving public witness to the virtues of poverty and simplicity. The example of Saint Francis led them to an awareness of and recognition of their responsibilities toward their less fortunate fellow man. The association was incorporated in 1975 in order to provide for more diverse membership and to facilitate the charitable works of the association.

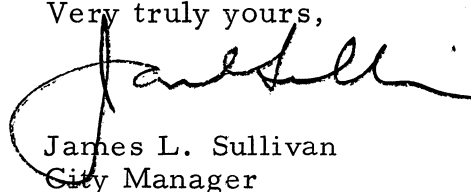
