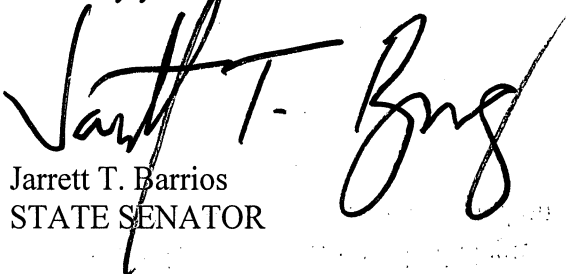
Dear Members of the City Council:
