## IN CITY COUNCIL

COUNCILLOR D. SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge desires the uninterrupted operation of job training programs for economically disadvantaged persons within the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Employment Resources, Inc. ("ERI") is a non-profit corporation designated as the Administrative Entity for the North Metro Service Delivery Area for all employment and training activities under the Job Training Partnership Act ("JTPA"); and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee, Inc. ("CEOC") is a non-profit corporation which agreed to provide services under JTPA as a contractor for ERI in accordance with the terms and conditions of a contract which terminated on June 30, 1985; and
- WHEREAS: This contract was extended from July 1, 1985 through December 31, 1985 under certain terms and conditions agreed to between ERI and CEOC; and
- WHEREAS: CEOC and ERI agreed in the July 1, 1985 contract extension that CEOC would be paid for its services as a contractor according to the seven conditions listed in the contract extension which CEOC and ERI agreed adequately protected ERI's interest that federal funds be expended only for contracted purposes; and
- WHEREAS: CEOC has provided valuable employment training services within the City of Cambridge for more than fifteen (15) years; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council supports the continued relationship between ERI and CEOC for the provision of services by CEOC under JTPA. The City Council urges ERI to meet and confer with CEOC concerning the possibility of CEOC's provision of further services under JTPA in the future. The City Council requests the City Manager to inform ERI that it urges favorable consideration of CEOC for provision of future job training services for ERI.
