IN CITY COUNCIL
January 14, 1985

- WHEREAS: There is a great deal of interest in and concern about possible far-reaching education legislation; and
- WHEREAS: Many people feel that previously proposed legislation is not well-understood and does not seem to have a focussed approach to school improvement and equal educational opportunity in the Commonwealth; and
- WHEREAS: There needs to be more input from the grassroots, especially from parents, as well as from local officials, therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council request the Education Committee to hold a series of meetings in cities around the Commonwealth and further that the Cambridge City Council invite the Committee to Cambridge, as one site for such meetings; and be it further
- ORDERED: That a copy of this resolution be sent to the Education Committee, our Legislative delegation, and the Governor.

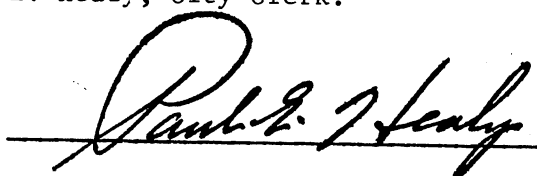
