In the year one thousand Eight hundred
and Sixty-seven.

An Ordinance
in addition to the Ordinance in relation
to Streets.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:

The first and second Sections of said
Ordinance shall not apply to any street,
so far as the same shall be contiguous to,
and parallel with any other street or way
already accepted, or laid out, or otherwise
a public way.
