Ordered,

That this Board recommend to the City Council the passage of an Order instructing the Joint-Committee on Roads and Bridges to contract, in behalf of the City, with some responsible person, or persons, to fill and make solid Prison Point-Bridge, forty feet in width, from the present South Westerly abutment of the Bridge to the Commissioners' line, substantially in accordance with the Specifications published by the Joint-Committee on Roads & Bridges of the last City Council, except as to the width of said filling; and also to contract with some responsible person, or persons, to build a substantial Bridge from said Commissioners' line to the middle of the draw at the dividing line between Cambridge and Charlestown. -
