- Duties: The Middle Grade Science Curriculum Implementation Workshop will focus on the following issues:
- Review the curriculum work done by Grades 7 & 8 teachers in the 1996/1997 science workshops, and develop a plan for implementing the 1997/1998 curriculum for the upcoming school year in Grades 7 & 8 in all schools.
 - The workshop will be held during the period of July 8-August 23, 1997. The exact dates are to be announced, but will not exceed a total of 10 days.
 - The workshop participants must work up to a maximum of 5 hours a day, 10 days, for a maximum total of 50 hours.

Participants must be knowledgeable about the Grades 7 & 8 science curriculum in Cambridge and the national science reform recommendations for middle school science.
