To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 7, dated January 8, 1990, regarding options for assisting parents attending City Council meetings, Jill Herold, Assistant City Manager for Human Services, recommends the following: that the Ackermann Room be designated as a space in which parents attending City Council meetings may be with their children. The space should be equipped with a cable television monitor in order for parents to follow the agenda of the meetings.

In addition, the Ackermann Room should be equipped with a small supply of toys and supplies which are appropriate for a broad range of age groups. Such a list has been developed by our child care staff with a total cost of approximately four hundred dollars. There will also be an additional cost for the acquisition of a television with a mobile stand.
