I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$22,000 in prepaid Fire Alarm fees from Harvard University to the Public Investment Fund Emergency Communications Extraordinary Expenditures Account to provide funds for the purchase of equipment necessary to ensure the compatibility of Harvard University's fire alarm monitoring network with the City's system.
