In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred, and Seventy-eight,

An Ordinance
in relation to the Salaries of certain
City Officers,

Be it ordained by the City
Council of the City of Cambridge, as
follows;

Section 1. The Salaries of the City
Officers hereinafter named, shall continue
and be paid as at present established,
until the first Monday in January 1879,
and no longer, namely:

<u>City Engineer,</u>	per year, \$	2750.-
<u>City Solicitor,</u>	"	2000.-
<u>Clerk of Committee,</u>	"	1500.-
<u>Superintendent of Streets,</u>	"	1800.-
<u>Chief Engineer Fire Department</u>	"	1200.-
<u>4 Assistant Engineers, do</u>	each	400.-
<u>Clerk of Board of Engineers of do. pr. yr.</u>		50.-
<u>City Messengers,</u>	"	1500.-
<u>Superintendent of Lamps,</u>		400.-
