- WHEREAS: On Monday, August 2nd, Mayor Duehay will welcome to the City of Cambridge, Luc Dupont, North American Regional President of the International Federation for Parent Education (IFPE), an organization dedicated to supporting parents and those who work with parents and families; and
- WHEREAS: The IFPE, founded thirty-five years ago in France, presents international conferences for policy makers and practitioners on topics related to parenting in today's world; and
- WHEREAS: Past colloquia have addressed such topics as "Globalization and Migration," "The Influence of the Media," "The Rights of Children to Education," and "Grandparents and Children: International Solidarity;" and
- WHEREAS: With a strong membership base in Europe and North Africa, and a growing presence in Latin America, especially Mexico, IFPE is currently launching an initiative to stimulate participation in the United States and Canada; and
- WHEREAS: For many years the IFPE has had consultative status with the United Nations and regularly participates in deliberations of ECOSOC (the U.N. Economic and Social Development Commission), UNESCO and UNICEF; and
- WHEREAS: Mayor Duehay and other city officials will meet with Mr. Dupont, board members of PARENTS FORUM and Marilyn Dalrymple, founder of Respect for Parents Day, celebrated each year on August 1st; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record as supporting the efforts of the IFPE and wish them well in their initiative to stimulate participation by the United States and Canada.
