WHEREAS: It is further reported that this agent fell all over the grounds where a child picked it up, ate it and got very sick therefor be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be directed to ask the Cambridge Housing Authority for a complete report on these activities, and be it further,

ORDERED: That pending this report, this poisonous agent be removed from Roosevelt Towers immediately and from any other buildings under the direction of the Housing Authority where it may be in use.
