

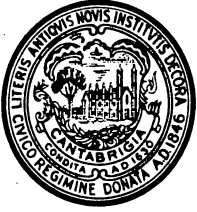

To the Honorable, the City Council:

RECOMMENDATION. Transfer \$55,000 from the Finance Department's Salary and Wage account to the Finance Department's Other Ordinary Maintenance account to complete the FY1984 property revaluation review and to begin the FY1985 valuation update.

BACKGROUND. In March of 1983 the City retained the services of R. M. Bradley Company to assist the Assessor's Department in the completion of the revaluation of commercial and industrial property within the City. To date, R. M. Bradley has assisted in the appraisal of approximately 1,750 properties, held 400 initial impact hearings with property owners or their representatives, and reviewed 700 abatement applications. For these services, the City has currently been billed \$213,186. The requested transfer of \$55,000 will cover final payments on the FY1984 revaluation (approximately \$30,000) and the establishment or increase in values on commercial property constructed or completed between January 1, 1983 and December 31, 1983. As the City Council is aware, one position on the Board of Assessors has been vacant for most of the current fiscal year. That position has been left vacant due to my desire to reorganize the office. When the full review of the 1984 revaluation process is completed, a report will be prepared for the City Council.
