This is a notice to our friends in the Cambridge community that interviews for carpenter apprentices in the Boston Carpenters Apprenticeship Program will be conducted on Wednesday, March 19, 1997. This program provides first-rate training for carpenters throughout the metropolitan Boston area.

As you know, Carpenters Local 40 has been actively encouraging Cambridge residents to apply for the program. In the last few years, we have been successful in recruiting some highly qualified young men and women from the city and we want to continue those efforts. As part of its standard outreach effort to schools, the Apprenticeship Program has already contacted the Occupational Education Department at Cambridge Rindge & Latin. However, we are asking you to inform other appropriate youth services and employment agencies about this opportunity in order to make sure that anyone who may be interested does apply. In addition, if you know of any interested individuals, please supply them with the following information.

In order to be interviewed, an applicant must apply in person on Monday, March 3, between 9 AM and 3 PM at the Boston Carpenters Apprenticeship Program at 385 Market St. in Brighton. They must be able to provide a high school diploma or GED. Anyone who does not apply on that date will not be eligible for an interview until 1998.

Please spread the word. This is an excellent opportunity for someone from Cambridge who is prepared to face the challenges of the construction industry and be trained to become a skilled and productive union carpenter.
