- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Francis J. "Bing" Connelly, retired Deputy Fire Chief and life long Cambridge resident; and
- WHEREAS: Deputy Chief Connelly served the people of Cambridge with dedication and a high degree of integrity for thirty years, prior to his retirement from active duty on March 31, 1978; and
- WHEREAS: Bing first entered the employ of the City on January 15, 1939 as a Firefighter assigned to Engine Company No. 3, and through a series of promotional examinations was promoted to the rank of Deputy Chief on November 5, 1957, the position from which he retired; and
- WHEREAS: Deputy Chief Connelly was known throughout the department as a fair but disciplined administrator and a person who truly enjoyed fire service, a personal characteristic which was evident from the enthusiasm he had for the job; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs Anna (O'Sullivan) Connelly and to the entire Connelly family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Connelly on behalf of the entire City Council.

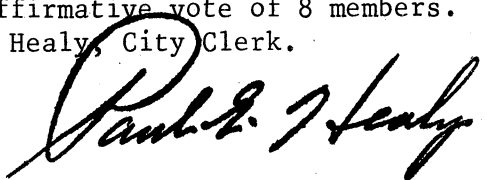
