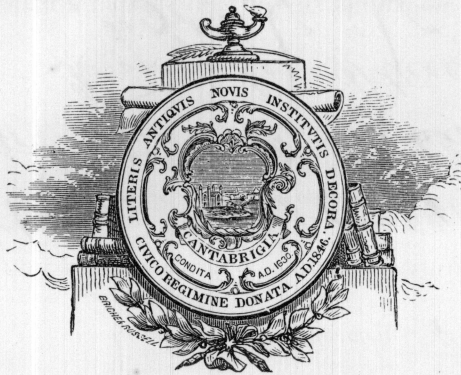

In Board of Aldermen, *February 21st, 1872*

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Main Street
be widened on its northerly side,
west of Temple Street.

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *the northerly side*
of Main Street, westerly from Temple
Street,

as is included between the *(red)* lines shown on a plan of *Main & Temple*
Streets drawn by the City Engineer, dated *Feby 7, 1872* and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Main*
——— Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said widening be estimated and awarded as follows:

To Charles K. Kirby
for

1585.5 sq. feet of land	@ \$2.25	\$3567.37
Moving 130 ft. fence	@ .10	13.00
		<u>\$3580.37</u>

Ordered, That *ninety days*, be allowed to the persons whose land is
taken for said *widening* for the removal of *fence* — standing
on the land so taken as aforesaid.
