ORDERED:

That the City Manager is requested to express to the President the sense of the Government of Cambridge that Cambridge is prepared to help develop among the citizens of Cambridge self-discipline and community discipline in matters of energy use, so as to assist the Government of the United States to:

1. Act decisively when such events as the Iranian crisis occurs.
2. Free the economy from the inflationary influence of OPEC oil pricing.
3. Permit alternative energy development to occur in a well-conceived and well-planned manner, with full regard for sound conservation and ecological principles.

and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager is then requested to identify ways in which the City can create of all Cambridge citizens a disciplined and coordinated population in matters of energy use, likely to serve as a model for other cities.
