Dear Mayor Duehay and City Councillors:

For the third year in a row, the Harvard Square Business Association is sponsoring an "Oktoberfest" in Harvard Square.

This year's festival will take place on Columbus Day Weekend. It is scheduled for Sunday, October 11th, with a raindate of Monday, October 12th. If the weather should prove too inclement on Columbus Day Weekend, then we have scheduled an additional raindate of Sunday, October 18th.

We are requesting the members of the City Council to support this event by attending it personally and by directing the following department heads to issue the various permits and licenses required to hold the event, namely:

1) the Chief of Police to issue three, one-day permits for the sale of food, beverages, and merchandise on October 11th or October 12th or October 18th; so that we can comply with the Massachusetts laws governing the observance of Sundays and holidays;

2) the Director of Traffic and Parking to permit the closing of Boylston Street between Mt. Auburn Street and Harvard Square on October 11th, 12th, or 18th, depending on the day of observance of the event;

3) the License Commission to issue a special three day license to sell wines and malt beverages by the cup, on October 11th, 12th, or 18th;

4) the Commissioner of Public Works to issue a sidewalk sales permit for October 11th, 12th, or 18th;

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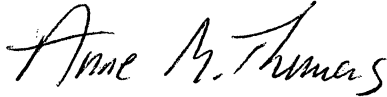
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5) the Cambridge Health Inspection Department to permit the sale of food and beverages outdoors, on October 11th, 12th, or 18th; and

6) the above or any other department heads not yet named to issue any permits or licenses omitted in this request.

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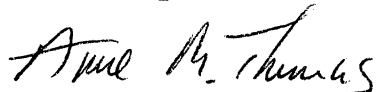
