December 30, 1974

WHEREAS:

John E. Bagwell, a former employee of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Fire Department on June 24, 1928 and was pensioned on September 25, 1943 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 57 of the General Laws and died on March 2, 1968, having served not less than fifteen years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Alice Bagwell, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32 Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by John E. Bagwell, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Alice Bagwell, widow of John E. Bagwell, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.

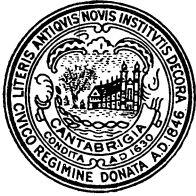


Re: Mrs. Alice Bagwell

Dear Mr. Sullivan:

I have examined the application of Mrs. Alice Bagwell and find it to be in order.

Under the provisions of Section 101, Chapter 32 of the General Laws, Mrs. Bagwell would be entitled to not more than half her husband's compensation but in accordance with our practice and the provisions of the statute in existence at the death of Mr. Bagwell in 1968, she is entitled to an annuity of \$1,200.00 which may be increased to \$1,600.00 if you see fit to implement the new provisions of Section 95A.


