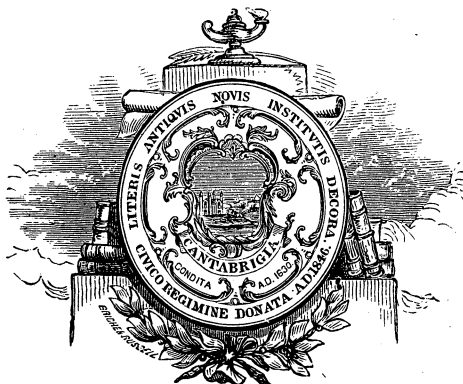


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen, *April 13th* 1871

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that *Main Street* should be widened

by taking for this purpose ^a certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *Main Street* in front of the estate of *A P Clark*

as is included between the *red & black* lines shown on a plan of *Main* Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *May 8th 1865* and now before this Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Main* Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said widening be estimated and awarded as follows:

To A P Clark for 225 sq feet of land \$1.00 per sq ft \$225.00

Ordered, That One Year, be allowed to the persons whose land is taken for said widening for the removal of all obstructions standing on the land so taken as aforesaid.

(Dec. 20, 1871.) Adopted. Sent down for the concurrence.
