In Board of Aldermen, Nov. 16. 1871.

Resolved, That the public convenience, and necessity require that Broadway should be widened on its Waltham side, near the corner of Winsor Street, by taking certain land belonging to Mary and Fanning:-

Therefore Ordered, That a strip of land on the Waltham side of Broadway, near the corner of Winsor Street, belonging to Mary and Fanning, containing seventy-nine square feet, being so much of her said land as lies South of the Waltham side of Broadway, as delineated on a Plan drawn by J. L. Chase City Engineer, dated Nov. 1, 1871, and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public way and a part of said Broadway.

Ordered, That damages for the land so taken be estimated and awarded at the sum of thirty nine dollars and fifty cents
