ORDERED:-

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 28, Regulation of Traffic; Article III, Section 4, Location of Bus Stops, trackless trolley stops, taxicab stands and service zones, the Metropolitan Transit Authority is hereby given permission to move the present outbound bus and trackless trolley stop located at No. 1925 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, on the near side of Davenport Street to the far side of Davenport Street near No. 1933 Massachusetts Avenue, to start at the far side of Davenport Street and to extend 65 feet westerly, and to move the two stanchions with signs reading "Trackless Trolley and Bus Stop - No Parking" to the new location.
