We have been advised by the Auditing Department that the balance in our F-7, Pensions account should be transferred to Miscellaneous Non-Contributory Pensions Revenue City.

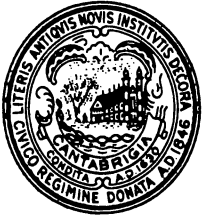


