There are many problems and issues to be discussed which affect neighborhood groups and it is difficult to give all persons who wish to be heard timely hearing on these matters without some procedural changes in the conduct of Council meetings, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That Her Honor the Mayor ~~be and~~ hereby is requested to arrange a schedule of meetings by the appropriate sub-committee of this City Council in all sections of the city in order to provide the earliest opportunity for all people in every neighborhood to be heard and to participate in the deliberations of this City Council on any issue which affects their neighborhood and is of vital concern to the residents of the areas involved.
