Dear Mr. Najarian:

We would like to inform you that several residents of 329 Harvard Street have chosen to form a tenants' association. During the preparation of our building's units for sale as condominiums, you will now be dealing with us as a united group rather than as individuals.

The letter dated July 10 that you sent out to all the residents was quite unclear. It does not provide us with enough facts from which to make an informed decision about purchasing our apartments or moving out. We request that you provide us with another letter that includes more concrete details about your schedule for renovating the building, your intentions toward the current residents, and our options as tenants.

In the interest of being treated with fairness and respect, we all intend to research our rights and protect them to the fullest extent of the law. We are willing to work things out with you in a reasonable manner, but please understand that these are our homes, and we want to be dealt with considerately.
