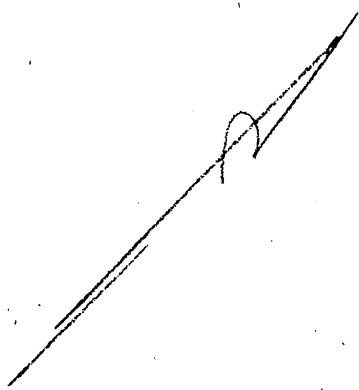
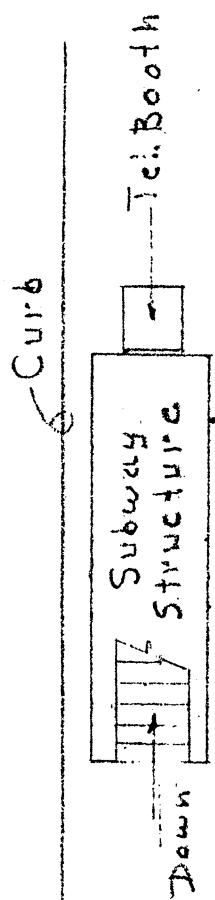

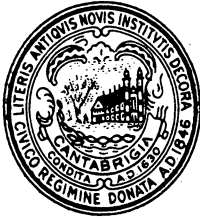
PART of CENTRAL SQ.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The petition of Bargains Unlimited to place racks and tables on the sidewalk has been referred to this office.

A site inspection by the City Engineer indicates as follows:

- 1.) Store is opposite a subway entrance structure.
- 2.) Distance from subway to store is 14 feet.
- 3.) 3 feet of table and 2 feet of occupancy by shoppers leaves 9-foot width of usable sidewalk for other pedestrians.

RECOMMENDATION: Grant permit on a 90-day trial basis subject to revocation during trial period.
