- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Paul M. Gately, lifelong Cambridge resident and community leader; and
- WHEREAS: Paul attended local schools and graduated from Boston State College, receiving a bachelor's degree and earned a master's degree in education from Boston University and upon graduation began working with the youth of Cambridge as both an outreach worker and as director of the Cambridge Youth Resources Bureau, a job he considered a labor of love, due to his deep personal commitment to children, particularly those who may be disadvantaged or handicapped; and
- WHEREAS: Paul served as the national coordinator for the International Year of the Child in 1979, traveling throughout the country promoting programs for children and upon the successful completion of this campaign, Paul worked for the United States Government serving with the United States Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, the Department of Health, Education and Welfare and finally became the chief security and training officer for the Veteran's Administration; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Anne Gately and the entire family at this unfortunate time of loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Gately on behalf of the entire City Council.
