

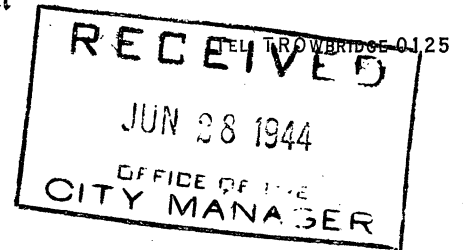

Dear Sir:

Upon receipt of Council Order to locate a street light in the vicinity of No. 70 Winthrop Street, I immediately requested the Cambridge Electric Light Company to do same.

I am now in receipt of a letter from the Cambridge Electric Light Company dated June 21, 1944, which is quoted below:

"We are unable to do this at this time because of a W.P.B. order contained in Utilities Standards as amended May 1, 1944, which states that street lighting fixtures shall not be spaced more closely than an average of one for each 500 ft. of street. The proposed light would be approximately 170 ft. from a light at Boylston and Winthrop Streets and therefore within the 500 ft. limit."

In connection with the request of your Honorable Body to locate a street light in the vicinity of #70 Winthrop Street, Cambridge, I wish to inform you that this request has been referred to the Cambridge Electric Light Company, who have advised us as follows:

"We are unable to do this at this time because of a W.P.B. order contained in Utilities Standards as amended May 1, 1944, which states that street lighting fixtures shall not be spaced more closely than an average of one for each 500 ft. of street. The proposed light would be approximately 170 ft. from a light at Boylston and Winthrop Streets and therefore within the 500 ft. limit."
