In reference to City Council Order of May 23, 1955, to increase the lumens in the lights at Sennott Park, please be advised that there are now 6 - 2500 lumen lights in this area. This, I believe is sufficient light for the cross-walks, entrances and exits, to and from this park.

These six lights are on 14 ft. poles, and to increase the lumens, we would have to install 22 ft. poles, as the shorter poles will not take a larger lamp.

Twenty six lamps have been broken in this area since January 1st, some of them being out for a week to ten days, before being reported. Therefore, I believe, that the darkness is caused, not by shortage of lamps, but by broken lamps.

For your information, these lights come under the jurisdiction of the Park Dept., and not the Electrical Dept., since they are not street lights.


