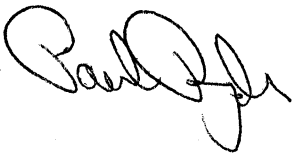

MEMORANDUM

DATE: May 10, 1991
SUBJECT: Council Order #31, dated 4/22/91

As a result of a community meeting held on May 8, 1991 regarding Hoyt Field conditions, the Department of Human Service Programs - Recreation Division has agreed to the following tasks:

1. Research the model used by other communities of using qualified volunteer labor to construct tot lots. All equipment and supplies would be purchased by the City and the equipment manufacturer would provide supervisory personnel.
2. The Department of Public Works - Parks and Forestry Division will install a limited amount of tot lot equipment such as sandbox and new swing seats in order to make short term improvements to the existing tot lot.
3. The Recreation Division will schedule a meeting with the Electrical Department to investigate the possibility of keeping on a limited number of field lights in order to improve site security.
