AN ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

1. Every owner of taxable real estate in the City who rents or leases any structures or portion thereof within the City shall file with the Board of Assessors on or before the fifteenth day of April of each year a statement under penalty of perjury on a form furnished by the Board of Assessors of the rent received for the real estate on each portion thereof for the period from January one to December 31 of the preceding year and an itemized accounting of all expenses attributable to said real estate.

Any owner of taxable real estate violating this ordinance shall be fined fifty dollars. Each day of violation shall be considered a separate offense.

2. All rental statements filed with the Board of Assessors shall be public records available for inspection by the public during the regular office hours of the Board of Assessors.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE LICENSE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN LICENSE FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the fees to be charged by the city of Cambridge for the issuance of the following licenses shall be such as may be established from time to time by the license commission of said city: auctioneers, common victualers and lodging houses.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
